

Introduction to the School of International Studies at Peking University

The School of International Studies (SIS) at Peking University is an important teaching and research platform devoted to specialized training in international politics, international political economy and diplomacy.

SIS was officially founded in 1996. However, the origins of the School can be traced back to 1960, when the Department of Political Science was re-established at PKU. Three years later, it was renamed the Department of International Politics. From 1996 to 1998, the Department of International Politics, the Institute of International Relations and the Institute of Asian-African Studies merged successively, and the new School of International Studies was established at Peking University.

SIS focuses on the teaching and research of international relations, diplomacy and comparative politics, including regional studies, with a special emphasis on China in world affairs. SIS hosts more than twenty research centers, covering issues such as strategic studies, security, energy, environment, international political economy, and many more. SIS publishes the *International Politics Quarterly*, together with several newsletters and annual collections. SIS works extensively with domestic and international partners on joint teaching and

research programs. Currently, the School of International Studies offers three English taught programs that lead to a Master's degree: the Master in International Relations, the PKU-LSE Double Degree in International Affairs, and the PKU-Sciences Po Dual Degree in Sustainable Development and International Relations. Presently, SIS has 54 faculty members. In the fall semester 2011, SIS had about 1,200 registered students, with nearly one-third coming from overseas.



About the Program

In order to encourage more international students to study International Relations in China and to prepare students in becoming successful international affairs professionals, the School of International Studies at Peking University set up the English taught Master's Degree Program in International Relations (MIR) in 2009 for international

students and applicants from the Chinese areas of Taiwan, Hong Kong, and Macao. Those who have a strong interest in global affairs in general and Chinese foreign relations in particular, and have obtained a solid undergraduate educational foundation are welcomed to apply. The students on this program are eligible to participate in international exchange programs.

After completion of the 2-year full-time program, including all required credits, a degree thesis, and an oral defense, a master's degree in International Relations will be granted by Peking University.

Application Prerequisites

1. Only international applicants and applicants from the Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan areas of China can be accepted into the MIR Program. Foreign applicants should hold valid passports issued by their countries, while applicants from the Chinese areas of Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan must be permanent inhabitants.



2. Applicants should be no older than 40 years old with at least a bachelor's degree or above from an institution of recognized standing.

3. Applicants from countries and regions where English is not the official language, or who did not receive their bachelor's degree from an English speaking university, are required to provide valid English test certificates - IELTS 7.0 or TOEFL 107(ibt).



3. Thesis



PKU-SCIENCES PO DUAL DEGREE IN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

About the program

The Peking University-Sciences Po Dual Degree in Sustainable Development and International Relations is a twoyear full-time program where the first year is spent at the Paris School of International Affairs (PSIA) of Sciences

Po, while the second year takes place at the School of International Studies of Peking University. The program is multidisciplinary by nature, designed especially to focus on the issues of sustainable development other than general international studies. The program stresses the linkages between public and private decision making on one side, and their multiple



determinants on the other side: technical, economic, legal, social, civil and natural. Students will acquire a global perspective on sustainable development issues such as biodiversity, energy, water and urbanization etc.


